- **Drive Thru** – Due to scheduling, the brick work around the canopy columns will be installed in August or September. After the brick work is done the rest of the siding and rain gutters will be installed. The electricity will be connected, and a dimmer switch will be installed to control the canopy lights. There will also be electric receptacles on 2 of the columns.
- **Ice Dam Project** – Phase One which made it possible for cold air to enter the attic is completed. Phase 2 which insulates the ductwork is on hold. Kent Johnson, Darrel Salberg and myself did a trial run and at that time, it was determined it was too hot in the attic to get a crew of volunteers involved. This will be done later this fall when the temperatures are cooler. Phase 3 which adds more blown in insulation will be determined after the air ducts are insulated.
