<u> John 6:24-35 (NRSV)</u>

²⁴So when the crowd saw that neither Jesus nor his disciples were there, they themselves got into the boats and went to Capernaum looking for Jesus. Verse²⁵When they found him on the other side of the sea, they said to him, "Rabbi, when did you come here?" Verse²⁶Jesus answered them, "Very truly, I tell you, you are looking for me, not because you saw signs, but because you ate your fill of the loaves. Verse²⁷Do not work for the food that perishes, but for the food that endures for eternal life, which the Son of Man will give you. For it is on him that God the Father has set his seal." Verse²⁸Then they said to him, "What must we do to perform the works of God?" Verse²⁹Jesus answered them, "This is the work of God, that you believe in him whom he has sent." Verse³⁰So they said to him, "What sign are you going to give us then, so that we may see it and believe you? What work are you performing? Verse³¹Our ancestors ate the manna in the wilderness; as it is written, 'He gave them bread from heaven to eat.'" Verse³²Then Jesus said to them, "Very truly, I tell you, it was not Moses who gave you the bread of God is that which comes down from heaven and gives life to the world." Whoever comes to me will never be hungry, and whoever believes in me will never be thirsty.

We called her "Little Anna," not because she was a child but because her frame had shrunk to the point she stood barely five feet tall. The driver of our church van told me that when he drove up to her house and pushed the button to open the sliding door on the other side of the van, she was so short he couldn't see her standing there. What he did see was her hand reaching up into the van with a can of beef stew for the neighborhood food shelf. I learned from Anna that if I wanted to influence parishioners to give to the food shelf or contribute to the World Hunger Appeal, it was best not to talk about it but to contribute myself. So when I tire of contributing food or money, I think of Anna and her can of beef stew.



This will be done later this fall when the temperatures are cooler. Phase 3 which adds more blown in insulation will be determined after the air ducts are insulated. 

Special Congregational Meeting Minutes 7-21-21

Meeting called to order by Kris Beck, 55 people in attendance. Kirstin Kempel gave a prayer to open the meeting.

Tellers: Stacy McKeever, Nancy Wrage, Jessica Peterson

<u>The Call</u>: Discussion was held in regards to calling Jaime Decker to be the pastor here at GA Church. It was stated that a start date will be August 23rd. A Motion was made to call Jaime as our pastor by Dennis Dahl, Kandyce Sandstrom second, no opposed motion carried. Ballots were cast, 55 total votes, all were yes. So Jaime Decker will be called as the pastor her at GA Church.

Compensation & Benefits: Kris Beck presented the benefits and compensation packages which included options of Pay with insurance and no experience, and the option of insurance and pay with 3 years experience. It was suggested from Synod that the 3 year option be followed for her experience while she was in school. It was discussed that the housing allowance could be removed as Jaime has her own home. Council will discuss that at a special meeting with Jaime. Jaime had asked to be a $\frac{3}{4}$ time pastor, it was discussed that if she went $\frac{3}{4}$ time then pay would decrease accordingly. Council is recommending full time not the $\frac{3}{4}$ pastor. A motion was made by Dennis Dahl, Second Chad Crandall to vote on whether $\frac{3}{4}$ or full time. All in favor, no opposed. A vote by hand was held and 48 for full time and 2 for $\frac{3}{4}$, rest chose not to vote, vote passed and it is decided that Taime will be expended that we are requesting full time.

that Jaime will be approached that we are requesting full time employment. Compensation packages were discussed and explained. A motion was made to vote on compensation package 2 by Jessica Peterson, 2nd by Kirstin Kempel, no opposed motion passed. Vote was held and 50 yes, 4 no, 1 no vote, so package 2 will be offered to Jaime for pay.
