¹⁴The Lord is my strength and my might; he has become my salvation.

¹⁵There are glad songs of victory in the tents of the righteous: "The right hand of the Lord does valiantly; ⁶the right hand of the Lord is exalted; the right hand of the Lord does valiantly."

¹⁷I shall not die, but I shall live, and recount the deeds of the Lord.

¹⁸The Lord has punished me severely, but he did not give me over to death.

¹⁹Open to me the gates of righteousness, that I may enter through them and give thanks to the Lord.

²⁰This is the gate of the Lord; the righteous shall enter through it.

²¹I thank you that you have answered me and have become my salvation.

²²The stone that the builders rejected has become the chief cornerstone.

²³This is the Lord's doing; it is marvelous in our eyes.

²⁴This is the day that the Lord has made; let us rejoice and be glad in it.

²⁵Save us, we beseech you, O Lord! O Lord, we beseech you, give us success!

²⁶Blessed is the one who comes in the name of the Lord. We bless you from the house of the Lord.

²⁷The Lord is God, and he has given us light. Bind the festal procession with branches, up to the horns of

the altar. ²⁸You are my God, and I will give thanks to you; you are my God, I will extol you.

²⁹O give thanks to the Lord, for he is good, for his steadfast love endures forever.

Devotion

"This is the day the LORD has made; let us rejoice and be glad in it." This verse was the theme of my parents' wedding and guided their marriage and relationship with their five sons. For them "the day" was the day of Jesus' resurrection. This was surely not the original intent of the psalmist, but the early church recognized these words as describing the way God's children were saved through the death and resurrection of God's Son. Jesus remains the gate through which God leads us to eternal life. Our response is simply gratitude. The psalmist concludes by giving thanks to the LORD for God's steadfast love, a common expression used in the Old Testament to affirm God's attitude toward all God's children. In this season of Easter we celebrate that love in the resurrected Christ.
