- Lutefisk: A committee was formed of Steve & Barb Melroe, Dennis Dahl, Betty & Duane Johnson, Joleen Hardy, Walter Wrage, Kris Beck, Sharon Beckstrom and Mike Larson to discuss the future of our annual Lutefisk Supper. After much discussion it was decided to table the supper this year. Attendance has gone down, price of fish and lack of workers. Our main issue is workers and someone to be willing to head up this event. This also effects the WELCA bake sale. We need to get creative and find a way to raise funds. We welcome any ideas. If many come forward and request we have the lutefisk supper and would be willing to commit, the committee would revisit this decision. - ➤ Thrift Items: Grace and Goods Thrift Store in Forman has asked GA Church if we'd be willing to be a drop off location for donations. Proceeds from their store fund services with the Kedish House and the Abuse Resource Network. Council voted on and approved this request, so if anyone has small items that you would like to donate to the thrift store, you may drop the items off at church during the secretary's hours, which are Tuesdays & Thursdays from 9:30-11:30 and Fridays from 11:00-3:00. - Congregational Meeting: Attention: Congregational Meeting on October 12th, 2025 to discuss replacing the roof. The GA Church roof has been leaking water for a few years in various areas of the church. Along with the Sunday School rooms and the kitchen, we are now experiencing leaks in the Fellowship Hall and above the southeast sanctuary door. After checking with various roofing companies, the GA Church council invites all members to a congregational meeting following the church service on October 12th. At this meeting, we will discuss the possibility of replacing the church roof and the necessary funding to pay for it. This is a substantial, but necessary undertaking if we want to prevent further damage to the church building. For over 100 years, GA has served as an integral place in Gwinner for people to gather to worship, fellowship, learn, serve, and grow. We will also have the 2nd vote to move the annual meeting to the second Sunday in February with the reports due on the last Sunday in January. It is our hope that you will join us on October 12th to help us decide how we can best serve our church and our community.
- ➤ <u>Spread the word!</u>: The fall Sunday School Session will begin October 5th and will run for six Sundays. We will not hold Sunday School on the long weekends when there is no school on Fridays. Our last day of Sunday School will be November 23rd.
