Special Church Council Meeting Minutes Date: July 1, 2025 Time: 7:00 PM

Call to Order Kirstin called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM. Members Present Martin, Sharon, Emma, Walter, Mike, and Kirstin. Also Present: Pastor Jaime

Purpose of Meeting This special meeting was held for discussion regarding the church roof. Roofing Discussion

- Walter presented a proposal from Ted at General Roofing out of Carrington for installing a steel roof.
- Ted's quote is valid for the current calendar year only.

• Quote includes option to install a steel roof on the sanctuary in the future, should our church choose to complete only the lower section at this time.

- A&B Roofing in Fargo provided a quote for a full shingle roof.
- Enterprise Roofing in Valley City also provided a quote for a full steel roof. Council Discussion
- Council expressed support for steel roof with Ted from General Roofing as the best option.

• Ideal project would be to install steel on the entire roof, excluding the canopy/carport, depending on available funds.

• Staged installation was discussed as a possibility, depending on Ted's assessment of the transitional areas between the sanctuary roof and the lower roof.

- Fundraising efforts would be necessary and planned.
- Council also discussed the possibility of selling the parsonage.

#### Action Items:

• Walter will contact Ted to schedule a visit to the church and assess the roof's transitional areas to help determine whether a partial or full roof replacement is needed at this time.

• Council discussed a congregational meeting in October to present project plans and gather input. Adjournment Martin made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Mike seconded the motion. Meeting adjourned at 7:51 PM.
