

JAMIARY 2024 ISSUE 1

December 12, 2023

President Kris Beck, called the regular meeting to order at 5:30 pm. Council members present Kris Beck, Martin Potts, Auston Creech, Paul White, Mike Larson, and Joleen Hardy. Also present, Pastor Jaime Decker.

Devotion and prayer led by: Pastor Jaime Decker

Secretary's Report. Motion to accept the minutes of the previous meeting. Hardy/Larson. All in favor, motion carried.

Church Work Group Reports:

1. Property and Grounds – Martin finished cleaning up in the parsonage yard, rock was moved. Auston is going to meet with Dylan and Carson for an estimate on insurance claim work from roof leak. Auston is also working with Chris Ferderer to fix the cross mounts at the front of the sanctuary.

Old Business and New Business:

- Building a community of generosity campaign reached the 40 intent cards needed for the match and then we were very fortunate for someone else to match with we received 50, we did. Thank you everyone for your generosity for GA.
- Pastor Jaime sent out a survey monkey for what things we can do to follow our mission, the results stated that people want to see more interactions with the youth and getting the youth to sing or play music during church and other times. So, we are discussing adding to our budget a afterschool program. The program will help kids with homework, and discussion of starting a children's choir or just music during church.

We paid the insurance for the year but will be holding off paying the synod for a while.

Put the thermometer up to show our budget and income. The budget for 2023 is \$195,310 and we have received \$180,165 so far this year. We need \$15,145 to meet the budget.

Still need to move the stuff from the storage unit which is in the altar guild room into the shed. Meeting dates need to be discussed, what works best.

Time and talent sheets need to be updated.

Christmas Eve service - only 4:00 pm service.

Need to have someone come and look at the geothermal wells to see if there is a problem because of all the sink holes around the parking lot area.

There will be a new tv installed in the fellowship hall to display the power point during services.

Talked about changing the Annual Meeting back up to February. Makes more sense for the budget. Pastor Jaime is on vacation January 7-17, 2024.
