

Secretary's Report: Motion to accept the minutes of the previous meeting. Paul/Mike. Motion carried.

Pastor's Report: Discussion of Pastor Jaime's April/May meetings, book study. She officiated a wedding, funeral, and a baptism. She attended a conference in Mpls., held a confirmation mentor meeting, attended a monthly Wahpteton Conference in Milnor, hosted today's council retreat at her home, and will attend her final 1st call retreat.
