

# Building a Community of Generosity

# "God Pause"

# <u>Stewardship</u>

Is G.A. important to you?

Over the course of a year, \$1 per day comes to a gift of \$365, which for about 35-40% of Americans would be significant growth in their giving to the church. The average Starbucks coffee costs \$2.75. This amounts to over \$1,000 if one is purchased every day of the year. The average Herbal Life tea costs \$6.

This amounts to over \$2,100 if one is purchased every day of the year, or \$312 if one is purchased every week for one year.

Regular, systematic giving can help all of us become more generous. We get overwhelmed when we think about larger numbers like \$1,000. However, most of us can find \$2.75 per day. As you think and pray about your generosity this year. Consider how systematic giving may help you become more generous.

Story from a member:

How important is Gustaf Adolf to you?

I recently overheard a conversation between two men. They were discussing the purchase of a new, bigger and better piece of lawn equipment for the lawn business of the younger man. The older gentleman was trying to explain to the younger man that new equipment would be a good investment for him. The younger mans reply, "I can't afford that! You know how much that costs?" Very patiently, the older gentleman went on to explain that by completing the job faster, then he would be able to finish more lawn jobs, thereby being able to make more money. "I get that," said the young guy, but he just couldn't get over the initial cost of the item. The discussion continued back and forth for a few minutes. Eventually the older gentleman ended the conversation with this phrase. "You can always afford what is important to you."

I had never heard that phrase, but thinking about it, it's very true. Whether it's a fancy coffee at the drive-thru or eating out or whatever is important to you. You make it a priority you make it happen. So, this year, when completing your intent card ask yourself. How important is GA to you?

November 12th we will be mailing out letters with an Intent of Donation Card inside. We ask you to fill these cards out and bring them directly to worship on November 19th Stewardship Sunday, or return them in the mail. If GA receives 40 returned cards, GA will receive a generous gift of \$3000 from one of our GA Families. We hope this gift invites you to join in our building a culture of generosity at GA.
