# From The Intern Pastor

Unity. United. What does it mean?

This last week I started my fall semester of seminary classes. One of my classes is the New Testament- Galatians and Corinthians. We are studying Paul's letters. These last couple days of classes we have been reading, reflecting, and conversing about the message that was emphasized in Paul's letter to the Galatians. Paul repeatedly emphasizes the importance of one in Christ Jesus. Unity in Christ.

So what does this mean to be one in Christ Jesus? Does it mean that we all have the same ethnic, social, and sexual origins? That we are all the same and these categories no longer exist? Nope! Being united in Christ does not do away with these differences but rather it makes these differences irrelevant before God. A commentary by Charles B. Cousar states, "Paul declares that unity in Christ destroys the barriers, the hostility, the chauvinism, and the sense of superiority and inferiority between these differences/categories." Our identity is not determined by the law but by our faith in Christ which unites us together as a community, as brothers and sisters who are included in the fulfillment of God's promise. The fact that these differences are irrelevant, they no longer matter, in the unity of Christ means we are to treat each other in this light (without hostility, barriers, chauvinism, superiority, inferiority) in the total affairs of life.

Faith in Jesus Christ gives us freedom. Freedom to be in relationship with people who are different from ourselves, freedom to risk loving one another, freedom to carry each other's burdens and hardships, freedom to change our minds, values, and beliefs when those thoughts, values, beliefs no longer fit into the the box that we have drawn around ourselves or the one we try to place around God. Jesus Christ's love for us unites us together and gives us the freedom to "come towards" a brother or sister in Christ whose values are deeply at odds with our own. Unity in Jesus Christ gives us freedom to face our differences not out of fear but out of love, gratefulness, and mutual respect.

The Spirit of Christ opens a future for us to be drawn into relationships based on love and freedom. Today, in the United States of America where the nation seems more divided than united how does being one in Christ Jesus, where barriers, hostility, chauvinism, superiority, inferiority are destroyed, transform our conversations and interactions with our loved ones, friends, neighbors, community members, church members whose values are deeply at odds with our own? How or where is the Holy Spirit drawing us into relationships that unite us as brothers and sisters in Christ Jesus?

**Changes to Usher Duties:** First off thank you to everyone who helps with ushering at GA your help is greatly appreciated. With the impact of COVID-19 the ushering duties have changed just a little bit, the following list includes the new duties:

1. Prop front door open with door stop to prevent everyone touching it (before and after service) please shut it during service to keep bugs out
2. Ushers please direct people into the sanctuary, no loitering in the narthex, before and after service
3. Ushers will still hand out bulletins, church will provide gloves if needed
4. If there is communion there will be a table with the single serve cups set out in the back, just encourage everyone to take one on the way into service.
5. Offering tray will be set in the back of sanctuary just point it out for people to drop off their offering on way in or out.
6. Usher out a single row at a time when service is done to help with maintaining social distancing and reduce congestion.




