Matthew 16:13-20 (NRSV)

¹³Now when Jesus came into the district of Caesarea Philippi, he asked his disciples, "Who do people say that the Son of Man is?" Verse¹⁴And they said, "Some say John the Baptist, but others Elijah, and still others Jeremiah or one of the prophets." Verse¹⁵He said to them, "But who do you say that I am?"
